 - receive the previous year's accounts and auditors report
 - agree the election of Board Members
 - appoint the external auditors for the year ahead
- Invited to attend the occasional Special General Meeting (SGM)
- Able to stand for election to become a Board Member
- Able to nominate other Shareholders for election

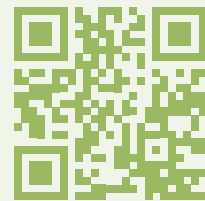
