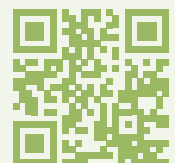
Where do we have garages?	Gala Park Gardens, Galashiels Kingsknowe Village, Galashiels Pirn Crescent, Innerleithen Plora Terrace, Innerleithen Bridgegate Court, Peebles Damcroft, Peebles	Ivanhoe, Peebles The Meadows, Peebles Blakehope Court, Tweedbank Cotgreen Road, Tweedbank Neidpath Court, Tweedbank Shielswood Court, Tweedbank
How do you apply for a garage?	You need to fill in a garage application form to be added to the waiting list. Link and QR code overleaf.	
How are garages allocated?	Priority is given to existing Eildon customers, after which garages are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.	
How much notice is needed to terminate a garage?	28 days' written notice must be provided.	
What about VAT?	VAT is payable on a garage rent if you are not an Eildon customer, so the garage rent is slightly higher to non-Eildon customers.	
How much is a garage?	2026/27 per calendar month (garage rents are increased each financial year) NON VAT £52.36 VAT £62.35	
Is there anything that cannot be stored in the garage?	Please do not keep anything flammable like petrol, diesel or oil. Gas cylinders are not allowed to be stored in our garages and lighting a fire or having a BBQ within a garage is not allowed. Any temporary power or electricity sources in the garage must be removed immediately after they have finished being used.
